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

ABSTRAK

Background : Births assistance by health personnel is one of the strategies addressing maternal and child health issues. In Indonesia maternity coverage by health personnel in 2010 was 84.78%, it had reached strategic plan delivery by health workers, but there are gaps percentage of deliveries by skilled health personnel between urban and rural. In urban, births assisted by health workers reached 91.4% and only 72.5% in rural areas.

This study is observational analytic with Sectional Cross design, aimed to analyze the determinant factors related to the selection of birth attendants in Herlang Health Care Centre, Herlang District, City of Bulukumba. The populations in this study were all mothers who were giving birth

This research consisted of 76 samples, taken using Purposive sampling method. Data were analyzed using logistic regression test with a significance level of 95%. The results showed that 75.0% chose birth attendants in maternal health care workers and only 25.0% who chose non-medical personnel, and of the six factors examined, there are four factors were significantly related, they are : education level ($p = 0.017$), distance to the health centre ($p = 0.003$), decision-making in the family ($p = 0.005$), family income ($p = 0.013$). While other two factors that are not related are, there is no significant knowledge ($p = 0.075$), mothers age ($p = 0.415$) with the selection of birth attendants in the Herlang Health Care Centre, Herlang District, Bulukumba City in

As the conclusion, that there is a significant correlation between the level of education, the distance to the place of health care, decision-making in the family and the family income, while there is not a significant correlation between the level of knowledge and mothers age to the selection of the births attendants.

It is recommended to the staff of Health Care Center of Herlang, that it is crucial and important to approach through the local culture and customs in the recruitment of health workers, improving access to health care, improving health education, and also coaching and training of the non- medical birth attendant need to be developed.
